#### **Lessons & Curriculum**

- Create a math lesson out of planning and planting your fall season crops by using the Square Foot Gardening method. Students can count, measure, calculate perimeter and square feet.
- Turn the compost bin and record the different items inside. Do you find decomposers? Is it balanced with 1/3 "greens" and 2/3 "browns"? Predict how the pile will look in the spring.
