- Start getting ready for spring planting by cleaning up anything you didn't get to in the garden at the end of the fall. Turn and sift your compost.
- Test hoses and watering cans for leaks, replace tools as needed so you're ready for spring.

Lessons & Curriculum

- Create a map of the garden. This should include the layout of the beds and what you plan to plant. It's a great way to practice creating models with scale and cardinal directions.
