Garden Tasks

- Harvest produce growing from the summer.
- Continue to plant cool season crops until the middle of the month (Carrots, Cilantro, Kale, Lettuce, Peas, Radishes, Spinach, Swiss Chard). If you need seeds, we still have plenty of free seeds. See information in the box to the right.
- Pull out spent plants and add them to the compost.
 Save seeds to plant next year.
- · Plant a fall cover crop in any empty beds.
